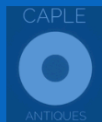
Job purpose

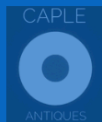

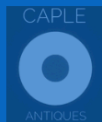

- Experience of having delivered practical coaching sessions to goalkeepers.



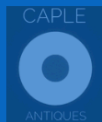

- Track record in working within interdisciplinary coaching team.



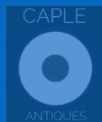
